REGISTRATION

EVALUATIONS

Evaluations will consist of two components: a) A paper evaluation addressing each talk (There is a Pre and Post assessment for Atopic Dermatitis within that document), and b) A very short electronic evaluation emailed by Peerpoint a few days after the conference. You must complete both paper and electronic formats, and submit the paper evaluation at the end of the day in order to receive a CME certificate.

Remember to complete the personal information section (name and address), so that we can credit you accordingly.

SIGN-IN/CME CERTIFICATES/MOC Part 2

Your signature on the roster (at the Registration Desk) and the completion of paper and electronic evaluations will qualify you for both CME and MOC Part 2. Turn in your completed evaluation forms at the end of the conference.

Both the ABP and ABIM no longer require pre and post evaluations for MOC Part 2. Instead, your participation in the conference, as well as answering key questions on your syllabus, will grant you as many MOC Part 2 points as CME claimed.
