**Carlo Reyes, MD, MS, Esq., FACEP**

After graduating from UCLA with a B.A. in Philosophy in 1992, Dr. Reyes attended the Chicago Medical School, where he obtained his M.D. and Masters Degree in Applied Physiology. He earned *Alpha Omega Alpha* Honors, which acknowledges the top 10% of medical students in the nation, and was also awarded the Chicago Medical School Board of Trustees Scholarship Award, given to the highest ranked medical student in the Clinical Sciences.

In 1998, Dr. Reyes was one of eight medical school graduates in the nation accepted into a unique 5-year dual-residency training program in Emergency Medicine and General Pediatrics. He served as Chief Resident for UCLA's Emergency Medicine/Pediatrics Combined Residency Program.

Dr. Reyes has served as clinical faculty in the Departments of Emergency Medicine and Pediatrics at Olive View-UCLA since completing his residency in 2003, and is a Clinical Assistant Professor at the David Geffen School of Medicine at UCLA. Dr. Reyes is the Assistant Medical Director in the Department of Emergency Medicine at Los Robles Hospital. From 2012-2014, Dr. Reyes was the Vice Chief of Staff of Los Robles Hospital. Currently, Dr. Reyes chairs the Bylaws Committee and is a continuing member of the Medical Executive Committee at Los Robles.

While working as a full-time physician, Dr. Reyes attended Southwestern Law School, graduating in 2010. He was a Junior Editor for the Southwestern International Law Journal, and a two-year member in the Southwestern Moot Court Team, placing 5<sup>th</sup>, then 1<sup>st</sup>, as Brief Writer in two nationally recognized competitions.

Dr. Reyes' contributions to the field of medicine, law, and the community are ongoing. In 2011, Dr. Reyes was granted the Frist Humanitarian Award at Los Robles Hospital. In 2013, the American Society of Healthcare Publication Editors (ASHPE) recognized Dr. Reyes as the 2012 Gold Award winner for his monthly medical-legal column, *At Your Defense*, published in *Emergency Medicine News*. Dr. Reyes is also a national speaker, recently speaking at the 2013 American College of Emergency Physicians Scientific Assembly, the 2013 California ACEP Assembly, and the 2013 Southern California Association for Healthcare Risk Management.
