The selected candidate will join a major academic medical center and established residency training program. The Director of the Pediatric Residency Program supervises all pediatric residency training, leading a team of associate program directors, chief residents, and other educators responsible for the execution of all residency training activities.

The posted UC salary scales set the minimum pay determined by rank and step at appointment. See Table 5. The minimum base salary range for this position is \$150,300-\$320,100. This position includes membership in the health sciences compensation plan which provides for eligibility for additional compensation.
